INDUSTRIAL VISIT



The final-year students of the Department of Computer Science, accompanied by two staff members, went on an industrial visit to ITC FCIL in Bangalore on 28.01.2024. The visit aimed to provide the students with real-world exposure to the operations of a leading company in the industry. Upon arrival, the group was warmly welcomed by Mr. Vivek, the HR of ITC FCIL.
