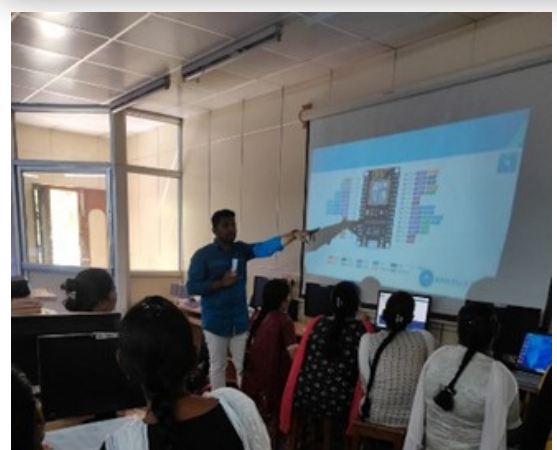

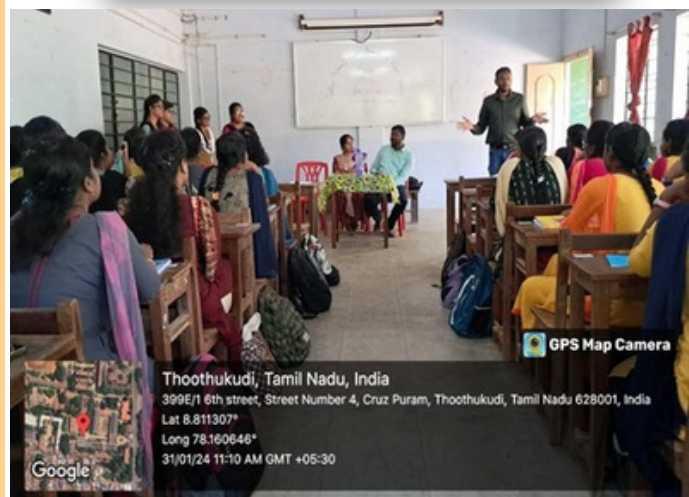
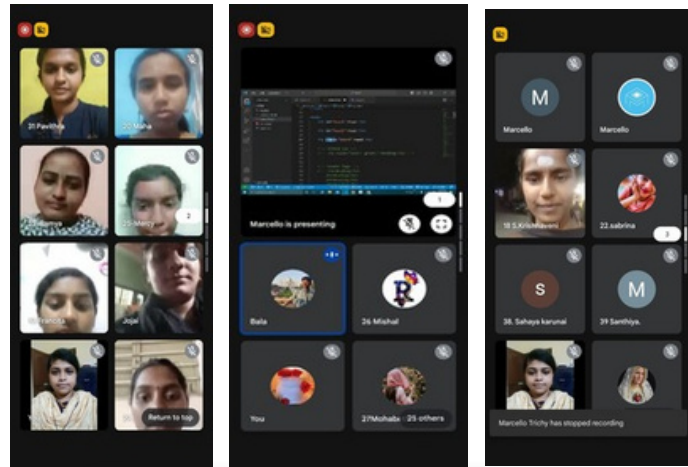
On December 13th, 2023, on the topic of 'Career Path Exploration', with A. G. Sharanya as the resource person .

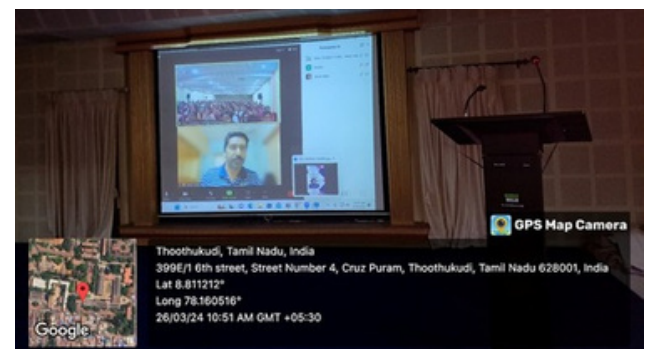
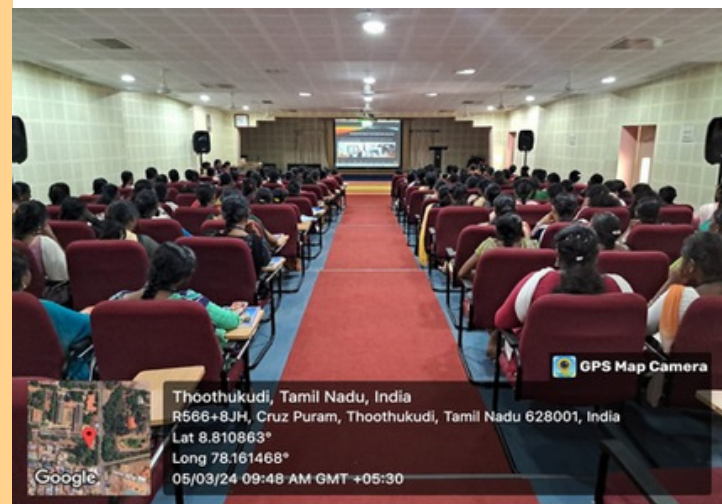

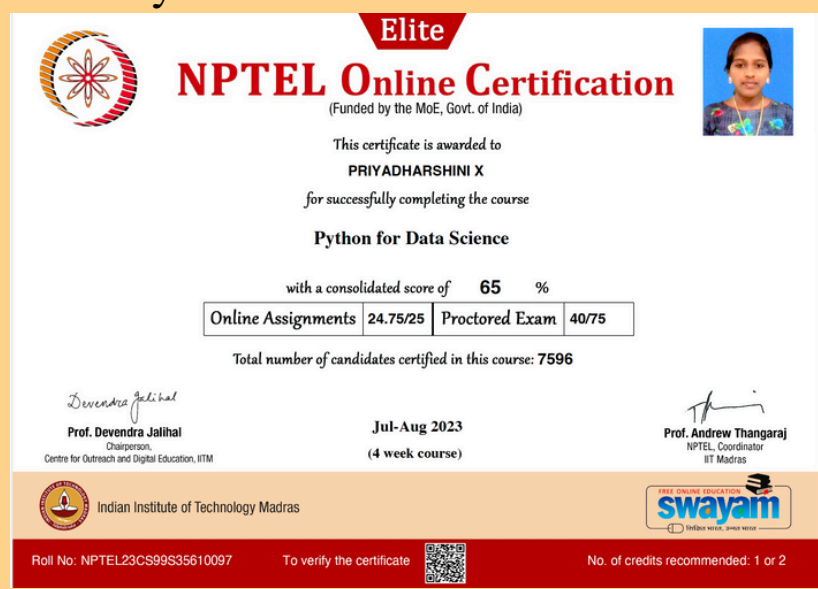

INDUSTRIAL VISIT

The final-year students of the Department of Computer Science, accompanied by two staff members, went on an industrial visit to ITC FCIL in Bangalore on 28.01.2024. The visit aimed to provide the students with real-world exposure to the operations of a leading company in the industry. Upon arrival, the group was warmly welcomed by Mr. Vivek, the HR of ITC FCIL. He provided an overview of the company's history, values, and mission, setting the stage for an engaging and enriching experience. Mr. Raj, the Product Manager, delivered a comprehensive presentation on ITC FCIL's products and services. This session offered insights into the innovative solutions the company provides and how technology plays a pivotal role in its offerings. After the presentation, the Product Manager guided the group through a tour of the manufacturing plant. The details of biscuit production were explained at different stages, elucidating the application of technology in optimizing processes.
