
1st July 2019


Under Econ Ward System, each faculty member is assigned a group of students as their wards. Faculty member has the additional voluntary responsibility of moulding and guiding their wards in all academic & personal fronts.

A schedule is prepared on Fridays to meet the students at least monthly twice. That was followed in a regular manner. 9 Ward Meets in Odd and 10 in Even Semesters.

- ➤ Econ Ward System is functioning under 5 Economists names. Adam Smith, Alfred Marshall, J.M. Keynes, T.R. Malthus and Amartya Sen.
- ➤ This system places about 34-40 students under each teacher who takes care and monitors the academic and psychological needs of their wards out of 176 students.
- ➤ During the meets the academic performance, attendance, classroom cleanliness, extra talents, class and campus behaviour, students' health aspect etc are noted and corrected.
- ➤ Sharing of their own problems with their mentors' serve a sigh of healthy relief to the students, thus enabling them peacefully concentrate on their studies.

ECON - JOB-ORIENTED COURSES

Department of Economics offered Certificate Course on Employability skills for Economics Graduates for II year B. A. Economics students in the academic year 2019-2020 from 09th July 2019 to 11st March 2020. It introduced to learn personal development, interpersonal skills and verbal & non- verbal skills.
