

IQAC 2024-25

The First Review Meeting of Self Study Report was held on 7th June 2024. The meeting was chaired by Rev. Sr. Dr. Jessie Fernando, Principal. Dr. B. Serena Margaret, IQAC, SIP & MOOC Coordinator & Associate Professor of English presented the detail report on activities of previous year with the participation of all IQAC members. The purpose of the meeting was to review the progress of quality assurance initiatives and plan for future activities aimed at enhancing institutional quality.

IQAC organised a Five Day Students Induction Programme for the I UG students from 26th June to 1st July 2024. Dr. B. Serena Margaret, IQAC, SIP & MOOC Coordinator & Associate Professor of English introduced the purpose and the conduct of the Students Induction Programme to the students and focused on the Universal Human Values. Dr. A. Punitha Tharani, Dean of Sciences & Associate Professor of Mathematics gave an orientation on “Outcome Based Education: A Glance.” The English Bridge Course threw light on the essential language skills which will elevate their academic performance. Dr. A. Jacintha Tamil Malar, Assistant Controller of Examinations & Assistant Professor of Botany gave an orientation on Examination- An Educational Assessment. Dr. K. Vinitha, Librarian highlighted on the Resources in the Library with its enormous rare and rich collections of books, e- books, the available facilities and the nlist e resources. Rev. Sr. Teresa Mary, Superior, Servite Convent delivered an Expert Talk on “Instilling Compassion and Kindness among today’s Youth.” Ms. F. Vesta Serapha, II M.A English Literature and Ms. K. 

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell submitted the data for National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2025 on 28th January 2025.



The IQAC conducted the Internal Academic Audit for the academic year 2022 - 2023 and 2023 - 2024 from 5th February to 7th February 2025. Dr. B. Serena Margaret, IQAC Coordinator

and IQAC members reviewed the academic audit report and suggested a few recommendations for improvement.

The IQAC started the document submission for Data Validation and Verification process for the Fifth Cycle of NAAC Accreditation on 30th January 2025. IQAC submitted the Data Validation and Verification on 14th February 2025.



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The IQAC conducted the External Peer Review on 20th & 21st February 2025 in the campus. Dr. S. Mohamed Haneef, IQAC Co-ordinator and Associate Professor, Department of English, Sadakathullah Appa College (Autonomous), Tirunelveli was the external expert for the departments from the School of Language and Culture and the School of Management and Economics. Dr. A. Lourdusamy, Deputy Principal, St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Palayamkottai was the external expert for the departments from the School of Physical and Computing Sciences and School of Biological Sciences. The IQAC Coordinator, the heads of the departments, the librarian, the physical director, and the counsellor presented the report of the academic, the sports and the cocurricular activities carried out in the academic year 2022-23 and 2023-24 to the external peer team. The external peer team visited the departments, assessed the documentation, and recommended a few suggestions for the enhanced performance of the institution in the academic arena.



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IQAC organised an Orientation Programme on Interactive Digital Panel on 24th February 2025. Mr. P. Saravanan, Senior Technical Support, Prama HiKvision, Madurai was the resource person. He explained the usage of each menu in the Interactive Digital Panel and how to operate the panel in a user friendly manner. Two faculty members from each department attended the programme.

IQAC conducted the Follow up Action meeting for AAA on 26th February 2025. All the members of IQAC attended the meeting and discussed the follow up action for the recommendations of the external experts who evaluated the performance of the institution in the AAA conducted on 20th & 21st February 2025.

IQAC meticulously structured the Certificate Course on Indian Knowledge System for the first post graduate students. The Certificate Course on Indian Knowledge System inaugurated on 18th March 2025. The objective of the course is to provide a comprehensive overview of Indian Knowledge System and make the students prepare for competitive exams. The course is conducted twice in a week and the duration of the course is thirty hours.



The Internal Mock Visit for NAAC Cycle V was conducted on 9th and 10th April 2025. The IQAC team visited the department and assessed the documentation.



The External Mock Visit for NAAC Cycle V was conducted on 12th April 2025 as a part of the preparation for the NAAC accreditation process. Dr. B. William Dharma Raja, Dean i/c., College Development Council, IQAC Director, Professor and Head, Department of Education, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli and Dr. H. Jimsy Asha, IQAC Coordinator & Assistant Professor, Department of English, Holy Cross College (Autonomous), Nagercoil were the enterprising experts of the mock visit. The interactive sessions with faculty members and administrative staff provided valuable insights and built confidence to face the official Peer Team. The expert members gave the valuable feedback and recommendations to enhance the areas of improvement and ensure the readiness for the official visit.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell organised an Orientation Programme on OBE Curriculum on 14th April 2025. Dr. Baba GnanaKumar, Professor & Director, Centre for Consultancy and Corporate Training, Department of Management Studies, Kristu Jayanti College, Bangalore was the resource person. He oriented the faculty members on OBE curriculum emphasizing Revised Bloom's Taxonomy in teaching and assessment strategies.
