Workshop : Creating Blog for Google Generation in the 2.0 World - 12.03.19

PREAMBLE OF THE WORKSHOP

A blog (a truncation of the expression "weblog") is a discussion or informational website published on the Web consisting of discrete, often informal diary-style text entries (posts). Posts are typically displayed in reverse chronological order, so that the most recent post appears first, at the top of the web page. The emergence and growth of blogs in the late 1990s coincided with the advent of web publishing tools that facilitated the posting of content by non-technical users who did not have much experience with HTML or computer programming. Until 2009, blogs were usually the work of a single individual. In the 2010s, the majority are interactive Web 2.0 websites, allowing visitors to leave online comments, and it is this interactivity that distinguishes them from other static websites. In that sense, blogging can be seen as a form of social networking service. Indeed, bloggers do not only produce content to post on their blogs, but also often build social relations with their readers and other bloggers. There are many different types of blogs

- ✦ Personal blogs
- ✦ Collaborative blogs or group blogs
- ✦ Microblogging
- ✦ Corporate and organizational blogs
- ✦ Aggregated blogs

The Blogger's Code of Conduct is a proposal by Tim O'Reilly for bloggers to enforce civility on their blogs by being civil themselves and moderating comments on their blog. O'Reilly and others came up with a list of seven proposed ideas.

- * Take responsibility not just for your own words, but for the comments you allow on your blog.
- * Label your tolerance level for abusive comments.
- * Consider eliminating anonymous comments.
- * Ignore the trolls.
- * Take the conversation offline, and talk directly, or find an intermediary who can do so.

If you know someone who is behaving badly, tell them so.

- * Don't say anything online that you wouldn't say in person.

These ideas were predictably intensely discussed on the Web and in the media. While the Internet has continued to grow, with online activity and discourse only picking up both in positive and negative ways in terms of blog interaction, the proposed code has drawn more widespread attention to the necessity of monitoring blogging activity and social norms being as important online as offline. Creating a Blog being the agenda of the workshop considering the legal and social consequences here we are on the move.


ABOUT THE COLLEGE


ABOUT THE LIBRARY

More serious connotations of plagiarism: Theft / Stealing / Usurpation / Appropriation/ Fraud/ Crime /offence/ Paying/ buying. Plagiarism could be of any of the following: Textual object of plagiarism, Intellectual object of plagiarism, Plagiarism of other than external sources such as Copying other students. Citation may not be enough. Here comes the concept of Publication ethics and Intellectual Property Rights.
