Six years have passed by ever since we attained autonomy. Two batches of U.G. students and three batches of P.G. students have successfully completed their course, and have moved out of the 'Marian fold' to explore new avenues. Their ventures and success bear testimony to the quality of education imparted to them. The institution always aims at a holistic development of the students entrusted in its care.

The present academic year records the strength of the regular courses as 1838 and the increased number of 942 in the self-financing stream, with the introduction of the new Commerce Course with Computer Applications. Teachers are indispensable to the growth of an institution. 78 learning professors and 44 supportive staff members from the regular course, 31 professors and 4 administrative staff members from Self Supporting Courses, determined to sustain the quality of education, dedicate their time, energy and brainpower towards the upliftment of the students' community.

Autonomy has been instrumental in developing research-oriented aptitude among the staff members and the students. Faculty members demonstrate keen interest in writing proposals to avail major, minor research projects. Mrs. X. Esther Vimala, The Dean of Arts and Associate Professor of Department of Economics and Sr. Arockia Jenecius Alphonse of the Department of Botany got their projects sanctioned at a cost of Rs.2,10,000 and Rs. 3,70,000 respectively. I congratulate them for their sincere efforts and wish that they scale greater heights in the years to come. It is also the most befitting moment to appreciate and applaud the new Doctorate holders, Head of the Department of Physics, Dr. Eucharista Immaculate Sylvia, Dr. Annie Francis of

the Department of English, Dr. Juliette of Department of Economics, Dr. Dayana Lobo, Department of Botany, Dr.R. Priyanka of Department of Business Administration and Dr.Siluvai Kirubagari Aneesiya of Department of Microbiology on their conferment of Doctoral Diploma in their fields. Our Research Centres keep producing successful doctoral candidates under the able guidance of scholarly guides. At this juncture, I would also like to felicitate three of our staff members and one student, Dr. Mrs. A. M. Sonal, Department of Tamil, Miss.Sharon Roque Corera, Department of English and Ms.A.Thivya Jothi, Department of MHRM and Ms.Vanaparvathi of II English Literature on their recent visit to Malaysia to attend IX World Tamil Conference and to present papers there. KUDOS to you on your new ventures!

A significant highlight of the present academic year is that the Department of Mathematics was upgraded as Research Centre on 22nd of August 2015. 65 years after its inception, the remarkable event brought the dedicated service of the pioneers of the department to a fruitful achievement. Dr. Mrs. P.Kala, Associate Professor of Mathematics of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University presided over the function.

A two day National Seminar was conducted by the Department of Mathematics on the theme "**International Year of Mathematics for the Planet Earth 2013**" on 17th and 18th of July.

The Department of Microbiology conducted a National Level Workshop to provide technical skills and practical knowledge on Molecular Biotechnology on 16th and 17th of September. The Department of Physics conducted an International

conference on the topic **Solar energy** on 11th of February. The Department of Botany intends to conduct a National Seminar in the month of March on the topic "**Bioprospecting Conservation and Sustainable use of Marine Resources**".

The experience and resourcefulness of great stalwarts of education have been beneficially brought to light by the new administrative posts created in this academic year. I sincerely thank Dr. Mrs. Maria Victorial Rani, Dean of Research, Dr. Mrs. R.D. Thilaga, Dean of Science and Marine Studies and Dr. Mrs. Judy Pinheiro, Dean of students for their commendable support and commitment to their service for the past one year and I wish them greater success in their future endeavours.

The Internal Quality Assurance cell conducted a workshop on 19th September 2014, on enhancing quality Measures in Autonomous Institutions. Dr. V. Sridevi, Associate Professor of Chemistry & Coordinator, IQAC, Lady Doak College (Autonomous), Madurai, was the resource person. Five of our Senior Faculty members attended a two day IQAC National Seminar on "Innovations in Student-Centered Teaching-Learning Process in 21st Century" in St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Palayamkottai and presented papers. IQAC, in collaboration with Placement Cell of our College conducts a workshop on **Journalsim and Life Skills** on 20th February 2015. Dr.V.Natarajan, Head of the Department of Journalism and Communication, Periyar University, Salem addresses the P.G Literature students on **Journalism** and all the outgoing UG students on **Life Skills**. With a view to preparing the faculty for restructuring the syllabus, the IQAC organises a workshop on Curriculum Development on 17th February 2015. Dr. Geetha

Swaminathan, Retired Professor from Stella Mary's College will address the gathering.

Our **library**, the perennial gateway to knowledge keeps expanding its horizon to enrich and empower knowledge to the user community. Keeping up with the latest trends of technological era, the library has easy access to E resources and bibliographic database which consists of 2154 e-journals and 51,746 e-books. The library is Wi-Fi enabled and so the user community has access to internet and e-resources within the library premises. The department of library firmly believes in updation of knowledge; hence every year a one day seminar is conducted for the benefit of P.G. students and research scholars. The changing role of library in dissemination of knowledge in the electronic form was focussed and thrust on "Library without Walls" was beneficial to a large number of students.

Certificate courses like Spoken English, Hindi, Tally, Computer Application, Insurance Consultancy, Women Entrepreneurship, Dietetics and Herbal Care, are offered to the I and II year Undergraduate students. The Department of Zoology continues to conduct Career Oriented Programme on "Ornamental Fish Management" with the seed money received from UGC. These supplementary courses augment the employability scope of the students.

The Marian family is obliged to bid adieu to its employees on their retirement. This is the most befitting moment to place on record the long fruitful service of 35 years of **Mr. P. Ravindran B.Com** who retired from service as Superintendent of Office. He has been the backbone of Staff Office, equipped with the knowledge of rules and regulations of bureaucratic affairs. He has

been a great support to able administrators. His retirement has created a void which cannot be filled.

Mr. Clements Fernando, Special Grade Lab Assistant has put in 32 years of service. A person with religious conviction, he executed his duties in the most perfect way to make the auditorium resonate with lively music and voices of the powerful orators.

Tmt J. Joseph Anthony Vanitha, Special Grade Lab Assistant has contributed a long span of 38 years of service in our institution. She is a lovable lady with a friendly, cheerful temperament. A duty-conscious person, she is prompt on service, perfect in her duty and poised in her behaviour. We wish and pray that she is blessed by Lord Almighty to lead a peaceful retired life.

We commend and congratulate four of our supportive staff members who have made their mark by their 25 years of dedicated and committed service to the institution. We recognise and honour the faithful services of Thiru S. Santhiya, Office Assistant, Thiru S.Selvaraj, Record Clerk, Tmt F. Jessie Conselia Navamony and Tmt S. Santha, Junior Assistants.

The academic year commenced on 16th of June. Rev.Fr.Wilson, Director of Anugraha Counselling Center, oriented the staff on understanding child, teenager and youth behaviour. He also gave suggestions for healthy living. On **June 18th** he gave an orientation for students. In a lively interactive session, students were taught the values of ethical behaviour. An MoU has been signed with Anugraha Counselling Center. On **June 23rd** College began for the first year students. They were accorded a warm welcome. Vice Principal, Sr.Reetha equipped

the students with the rules and regulations of the institution. On **July 2nd** Classes for the first year P.G.Students commenced.

On **July 8th** the Students' Council election was held. Electronic method of voting was adopted. Miss.K.Priyanka of III B.A.English Literature, Miss. R. Jemimah Stannie of III B.Sc Mathematics, Miss. U. Pasteena of III.B.Sc.Physics were elected as President, Secretary and Vice-president respectively and Miss.Padma Arthy of III.B.A.English, SSC and I.Reeshman Anjum of III. B.Com were elected as President and Secretary of Self Supporting Courses. G. Subasri of III. B.Com, P. Vasuki of III B.Sc. Computer science and Ruby of B.Sc.Microbiology were delegated as student coordinators.

On **July 15th** the Students' Council was inaugurated by Rev.Sr.Josephine Nirmala Mary, Principal of Fatima College, Madurai. Student Council members along with the student representatives of various committees and associations pledged to duly execute their duties assigned to them. The Deans and Staff coordinators also participated in the dignified investiture ceremony. The academic year's theme of gratitude was launched in the inaugural function of Students' Council. All the activities were focussed on the value of gratitude, to elders, parents, ancestors, country and the fellow human beings, paving way for the prime value of recognition of the service and grace received from the others in the society.

On **August 7th and 8th** a workshop on Time Management and Leadership was organised for the staff and students. Rev. Fr. Pavul Raj from Gregorian University addressed on prioritizing work in managing time effectively and further offered some guidelines to enhance leadership qualities.

Students pay their due respect to the Nation on the national festival days and to the teachers on **Teachers' Day** in meaningful celebrations. This year Mrs. Uma Kanagaraj of All India Radio, Thoothukudi presided over the Teachers' Day Celebration. As part of the meaningful celebration on the Independence day, the outgoing UG and PG students were oriented on 'Facts of Life' by Rev. Dr. Sr. Joan of Arc Mary, OSM, of St. Joseph's hospital, Uvari. She addressed the students on the need for a healthy living, a life of understanding both in the emotional and physical level for familial progress which of course is an essential feature for social progress.

Career Guidance and Placement Cell conducts a structured training program for aspirants of IAS, IPS and other public service commission exams. Special focus is being given to conduct aptitude test periodically to students so as to get them ready to face such exams conducted by corporates during campus and off campus recruitment. 17 of our students were selected by Velammal Educational Institutions for various faculty positions. 5 of our students were absorbed by Cognizant Technologies in an off campus recruitment drive at Sathakathulla Appa College.

All the students must choose any one of the co-curricular activities. **National Cadet Corps** in our college functions with an objective of inculcating unity and discipline among the cadets. It instills a spirit of selfless service to mankind through various social service activities. The cadets are trained to develop courage and comradeship to work together for the betterment of the society. The NCC unit of our College comprises 85 cadets. As per the new frame initiated in the academic year 2013-14, the cadets who are enrolled this year will undergo NCC training for three

years. Apart from the regular training in the institution, the cadets get a wide exposure to interact with other cadets all over the country, by participating in various National camps like **All India Girls' Trekking Camp-2014, National Integration Camp** conducted at Udaipur, Rajasthan, **Tulsani Camp, Annual Training Camp, Combined Annual Training Camp, Basic Leadership Camp, National Integration Camp** conducted at Bhupal Nobels' College, Udaipur, Rajasthan. It is note worthy that G. Jerlin of II B.Sc. Physics and S. Vana Parvathy of II B.A English Literature (SSC) attended the **Republic Day Camp** held at Sri Saradha College and were selected for the **Inter Group Competition Training**.

In addition to the camps, our cadets also involve actively in the social service activities and social awareness programmes. Our cadets involved in cleaning the Railway station at Thoothukudi on 02.10.2014 as an initiative of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. Cadets were taken to the Home for the Aged, Thoothukudi, run by the Little Sisters of the Poor on 09.01.2015. Our students performed various programmes and entertained the old people. On the whole, NCC unit in our college strives to groom our students to be responsible leaders of tomorrow

National Service Scheme orients the youth towards their commitment to the society where they belong. The wider perception of including the others, specially the marginalised section of the society helps eliminate self-centredness and egoism which are the prime causes of concern in the present generation. The four units of N.S.S function efficiently, exposing our girls to the global problems like zone depletion and climatic changes, developing a sense of social and civic responsibility by cleaning

the VOC Port beach and Muthu Nagar Beach. Blood Donation camp was organized in September. R. Shanthi, Blood Bank Medical Officer, Government Hospital, Thoothukudi addressed the gathering on the vital necessity of blood donation and inaugurated the camp. 108 students voluntarily donated blood. Invited lectures by reputed officials develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities. All our activities reflect the essence of democratic living and uphold the need for selfless service.

A team of five doctors and ten attendants from Thoothukudi Municipal Corporation, Public Welfare Division created awareness among the students to prevent an outbreak of dengue through their informative lectures and power point presentation. The college campus was fumigated at the end of the camp. A group of twenty five students escorted by two NSS Programme Officers took part in a walkathon arranged by the coast guards on 6th February.

Academics with linkage to the society will certainly be a fruitful exercise. The students are made to realize their responsibility as citizens through **Community Development Programme**, by name TOUCH. The students, equipped with awareness and knowledge of useful health tips, beneficial schemes of the women Empowerment Programmes, are engaged in effective institution community partnership. Each department has adopted an area within 10 kilometre proximity. They make a mark of their presence through adult literacy programmes, training programmes on self-employment and awareness programmes on health and hygiene. Celebration of festivals like Christmas, Pongal and Womens' Day in their midst increases their happiness

and joy. The motto of our 'TOUCH' programme is 'SERVE and LEARN'. The programme widens the perspective of the students and makes them become conscious of the stark reality of the life of the marginalized sections of the society. The outlook of the adopted village people also undergoes a great change in the process.

The college aims at the holistic development of the students entering its portals. The arena of **Sports** is ever vibrant with agile players, exhibiting their calibre in multifaceted ways. The institution provides unfailing attention to their needs to develop their abilities, thanks to the untiring efforts of our Physical Directoress, Mrs. Josephal. In the 24th Manonmaniam Sundaranar University Intercollegiate tournaments, conducted in various colleges our players bagged the overall shield; hence we are the champion college and we have retained the trophy this year also, for the 22nd time. Victory in the District Level Women Sports Tournament and tournaments conducted by the District Sport Council of Tuticorin needs a special mention at this juncture. Kudos to our players and their team spirit! Kudos to our athletes and their skills!

Eco club has implemented various eco friendly activities across the length and breadth of the campus in view of protecting the environment from plastic pollution. Usage of disposable pens and digital banners, sale of soft drinks and drinking water in non biodegradable packages were banned. The World Ozone day on 16th September was observed with mini marathon race from St. Mary's college front gate to Roche park and return to the College. Nearly 600 students showed their mettle through their success in finishing the race. In order to give awareness among students on

ozone and its significance, a debate was conducted by Rev. Sr. Jeny, Assistant Professor from the Department of Botany. With a bid to launch the National scheme "Swachha Bharat Abhiyan" the eco club members have been allotted duties to maintain a clean environment in the campus.

AICUF chapter of our college reiterates the motto of the organisation "We are born in an unjust world. We must definitely change it" in all its activities throughout the academic year. On ozone day, a debate was conducted to make the students become aware of the importance of ozone. On World Food day, awareness was created regarding the value of food and the importance of its conservation and helping others. Food was supplied to the nomads of the town. Students participated in a tele dialogue 'Expectations of the youth in Catholic church'. The dialogue centred around the role of church in guiding the youth in spiritualism and society the opportunities to be given to the youth to take part in the church. St. Mary's Swachi Bachan intended to clean the entire campus, involving the students, staff and supportive staff. Visit to the Bethany Home and the efforts of the volunteers to please the inmates through their cultural programme turned out to be an unforgettable event for all of them.

Our students hail from diversified backgrounds and most of them are first generation learners. The influence of media and the changing trends in the society are wreaking havoc in their personal life. They face traumatic problems and they are in dire need of psychological counselling. **Our Counselling forum** leads the students in regular one to one counselling. Mr. Jegan, a star trainer from Madurai conducted Life Skill Training

Programme as a self awareness session in the morning followed by a mind blowing session in the evening. The forum offered a grand and holistic mass counselling to all the students in the open air auditorium on 13th September. The vibrant youth were highly motivated to face new challenges in life and also learnt to respect and love their parents and elders.

Tutor-Ward system enables us to keep a track record of the academic and mental progress of the students. Each staff member is entrusted with a group of twenty students whom they meet periodically to counsel, if the need arises. The rapport between staff-student relation is strengthened and the students are psychologically secure in the hands of 'a second mother' in the campus.

Days of social significance and birthdays of national, international leaders are commemorated and the message creates the awareness of the societal and environmental problems among the students. On October 16th World Food day was observed. Mr. Raja Raman, Nature Charity Trust, who has undertaken the noble task of providing food to the poor, was invited. Students and staff contributed to his mission. International day of Violence against women was observed on November 25th by a rally in which all the students took part to show their protest.

FSS, Friends of Servite sisters is an informal association wherein the staff, students and members of the management gather together to be involved in spiritual exercise. The feast of our Lady of Sorrows was celebrated on 13th September. The seven values upheld by our Lady of Sorrows were explained to the large gathering of students. A common prayer service was held.

The **Parent Teachers Association** enables us to promote a healthy relationship between the educators and the stakeholders. The coordination between the teachers and the parents paves way for academic and psychological development of the students. The meeting of parents teachers association for the II year Undergraduate students was held on 23.08.2014. Mrs.Sasikala Pushpa MP officiated the gathering and delivered the keynote address. She relinquished some prominent points regarding the upliftment of student community. She also insisted on the necessity of women education and empowerment in today's world.

The first year students exhibited their potentials in “**Talentia**”, which is a platform to hone the skills of students in fine arts. Annual Fine arts Celebration creates an encouraging ambience to tap the latent creative potentialities of the budding artists. The best talent is recognised and rewarded. These students are exposed to the competitive world to compete with their peer groups from other reputed institutions. Some of the significant achievements of this year are the overall shield bagged in the cultural competitions conducted by Jaycees and “Muthamizh Kalai Kallori” award won at Mother Teresa University, Vagaikulam. Twenty five students participated in ICTACT TALK and ICTACT PRESENT competitions held at Tirunelveli. The **Consumer club** conducts quiz programmes with a bid to create awareness of issues and problems related to the consumers. **Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell and Anti Narcotics Club** organized a meeting in the college premises. Mrs. Subashini, Advocate , delivered a speech on “Prevention of sexual Harassment and creation of Drug free Society”.
