Dr. S. Mary Baptista Janet, Dean, School of Biological Sciences presented the Action Taken Report based on the 25<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting. The Deans' Office report was presented by Ms. M. Jothimani, Dean, School of Physical & Computing Sciences. It was confirmed by the house.

Computation of course outcomes attained - Assessment of PO, PSO and CO attained for II semester UG and PG

#### Related to 3/8:

Dr. K. Swarnalatha, University Nominee enquired about the assessment and how it is incorporated in the question paper Ms. M. Jothimani, Dean, School of Physical & Computing Sciences clarified that 60% of the question paper is of K1 to K3 level and 40% constitutes K4 and K5 level. K levels are not explicitly mentioned but students are given awareness about the K levels. She also explained that for assessing K levels for CIA excel sheets with the needed formulas and calculations are given to the individual staff member in charge of the course.

Dr. K. Swarnalatha, University Nominee said that in the University they mention COs, POs and K levels in the question paper and circulate it among the students. Dr. K. Swarnalatha suggested that the assessment can be done through ERP. Ms. M. Jothimani, Dean, School of Physical & Computing Sciences assured that it will be followed from the next academic year. # Related to 5/8:

Dr. K. Swarnalatha, University Nominee enquired about the question paper pattern and whether K level is specified. Ms. M. Jothimani explained the process ie for K1, K2, K3 (lower level) it is 60% and K4, K5 (higher level) it is 40%. Dr. Fernando Alexanderia clarified that the question paper with K level, CO and PO is mentioned in the question paper and kept in the department.

Dr. K. Swarnalatha requested for a model question paper pattern and she was furnished with one. She questioned why there are four sections in CIA and five in ESE for which Ms. M. Jothimani and Dr. Fernando Alexanderia answered that Section A for CIA is conducted in the form of online quiz for both UG & PG.

## Report of Semester Examination Results

# Related to 7/8:

Dr. K. Swarnalatha, University Nominee after going through the Semester Examination Results enquired about the poor result for I B.Sc. Mathematics and B.Com (Corporate). It was answered by the Head of the Department of Mathematics replied they are finding difficulty with the first year students. Dr. K. Swarnalatha, suggested to conduct remedial classes for which the HoD of Mathematics replied that remedial classes are conducted regularly for the slow learners. Dr. Sr. Jessie Fernando, Principal explained that for B.Com Corporate since number of students are less even the absence of one student affects the pass percentage. It was confirmed by the council.
