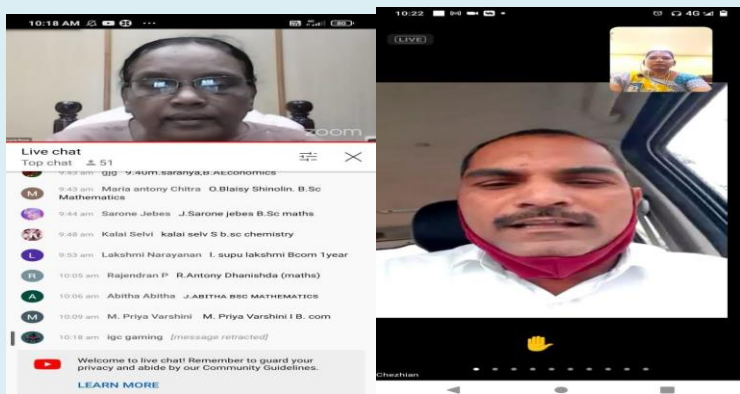

She explained the different types of parenting methods and also focused on the techniques of handling children of adolescent age.



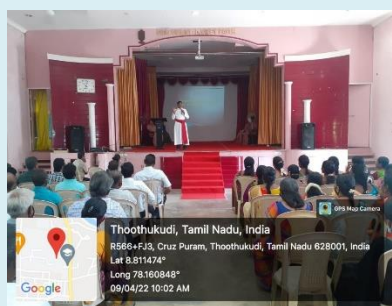
